

CLAN CODE OF CONDUCT: Adhere to for all classes

- All members are to respect the chain of command. If a member of higher rank has asked you to perform a task or duty it is your obligation to try your best to accomplish the request. You are not required to follow in game orders while in public play or melee time on team speak. However, during match play / clan events / etc, you are required to listen to those of higher rank and make every effort to comply to the best of your ability. Some matches/scrimms will have different rules and guidelines that will be setup by the WAR ADMIN of that particular event. Adhere to this at all times while in any clan event. You have the right to just come in to our servers and play, have fun, and goof off. You also must be aware that during official clan events you are required to follow the chain of command and know who your ranking members are. Stating you are oblivious is not an acceptable excuse.
- All members are to respect one another as to not infringe on another members rights to enjoy the game. Making loud annoying noises on clan media, being disruptive on clan media, or making rude or inappropriate remarks towards members / clans / etc can result in disciplinary action. You could be warned, kicked, or even banned depending on the severity of the offense the ranked official performing their duty.
- All members are expected to participate in clan activities. We understand that life is more important than the clan, but it is your responsibility as a member to participate or provide a reason why you can not participate. Failure to remain in communication with the clan could result in disciplinary action.
- No member shall kick or ban another member from any media without the proper authority or just cause. We will not tolerate abuse of power and all actions taken, regardless of who the reprimand came from, will be investigated and dealt with accordingly.
- The use of fowl language, flame comments, or any rude abusive remarks whether it be to other clans or on our public media will not be tolerated. It is your responsibility when wearing our tag to represent our clan as if you were the clan itself. This does not mean fowl language in our private media, such as the clan private forums or team speak will be stopped, we are just asking that you take into consideration other peoples views and be courteous. If your comments or language was displayed in a public forum or media you may indeed receive disciplinary action.
- The use of cheats, exploits, and any variance thereof is not tolerated. If it is found that you are using any of those to enhance your game play you will be terminated from the clan, banned from all media, and shamed to all clans we currently have contact with. You should never be accused of cheating by any member, including the CA, either publicly or private without a hearing by the GS/LS. This process would be conducted in secret if allegations were brought up against you and no-one would know the results or status unless you were found guilty.
- You can not be terminated from the clan without a proper hearing by the GS/LS and approved by the CA. However, temporary suspension and disciplinary action can be taken against you if you are violating policy or conducting yourself in a manner that does not best represent the 6th Armored Division.
- Please be aware that not every offense can be listed here. Use your best judgment when deciding to do something and your leadership will do the same when deciding what you did was just or not. If you feel like something you are about to do will be controversial --- then don't do it.



NO CLASS - No martial authority

PVT/ PFC- Trainee Non-Member / PV2- Private/ PFC Members do not have any rights or authority to kick, ban, or otherwise make decisions towards other members unless given such privileges temporarily by the leadership of the clan.



CLASS 1 - Limited martial authority

SPC /CPL /SGT - Specialist/ Corporal/ Sergeant Members can manage other enlisted Soldiers of lower rank in matches, clan events, and our clan media.

Code of Conduct CLASS 1:

- Members of this class can make a judgment call if another member of less rank is violating any of the following:
 - Making loud or annoying sounds in game, during a match, practice, or other events the clan may be

involved.

- Being disrespectful while on any clan media or sponsored media. This includes directing disrespect towards other members, other clans, visitors, etc.
- Any member not following specific guidelines stated by the leadership of the clan. This would include clan events, matches, practices, scrimms, etc.
- Members who do not follow orders during a scrim, match, or practice (depending on the war admin and how they run things.)

Possible actions: Members of this class must warn and try to find a member of higher rank, specifically in the GS, so they can handle the situation in the most appropriate way. They can either move all parties involved for a discussion, warn them outright and seek council by GS / LS members, and if the situation calls for an immediate kick, and there are no members from the GS/LS present, do so. !!! A warning must be given before any action is taken !!! Members of this class **MUST NOT TEMP BAN** members if they feel the situation calls for such action. Members of this class **MUST NOT TEMP LIMIT** access to media to limit the abuse of the members in question if the actions taken deem such a course. All actions taken must be reviewed by the GS/LS ASAP. If action taken was not just, or was too severe, than the member of this class who took such action could face disciplinary action by the GS/LS.

- Members understand that they may only take action towards members of lower rank. If the member in question currently holds the same rank as then they must seek a higher rank in order to take action. EX: One SSG can not take action towards another SSG, but can any rank below. Adhere to chain of command
- All actions taken by members of this class will be subject to review by the GS/LS. In some circumstances your decision maybe over-ruled and/or you may face disciplinary action. Just adhere to the BILL of RIGHTS when making your decision and any other policies or BILLS that pertain to such actions.
- It is your responsibility to know all policies, new and old, when making your decisions or taking action. There is no excuse for not knowing or being oblivious.



CLASS 2 - Moderate martial authority

SSG /SFC /MSG /1SG /SGM - Staff Sergeant/ Sergeant First Class/ Master Sergeant/ First Sergeant/ Sergeant Major Members have served with the clan for 6 months or more and have been deemed mature enough to handle moderate issues that arise within the clan. These members are to adhere to the following at all times before making a decision. Any decision that a member makes can result in disciplinary action against that member for taking action by the GS/LS.

CLASS 3 - Extensive martial authority

COMMAND SERGEANT MAJOR (CSM) & SERGEANT MAJOR OF THE ARMY

CSM Members & THE SERGEANT MAJOR OF THE ARMY MEMBER have been with the clan for a year or longer. These members have proven over time that they have the maturity, respect, and level headed record to

hold these ranks. These members have extensive martial authority to handle most major issues that arise within the clan and to make a decision. However, these members must adhere to the following at all times before making a decision and understand that any decision that they make can result in disciplinary action by the GS/LS. Note that this member is bound to maintain a proper professional atmosphere among staff, and carries out policies and standards on the performance, training, appearance and conduct of enlisted members.

****Sergeant Major of the Army** - You duties would include making sure that all SGTs & NCOs were performing their duties, assisting when necessary, and reporting your findings and recommendations to the GS/LS/CA.

Code of Conduct CLASS 3 members:

- Members of this class can make a judgment call if another member of less rank is violating any of the following:
 - Making loud or annoying sounds in game, during a match, practice, or other events the clan may be involved.
 - Being disrespectful while on any clan media or sponsored media. This includes directing their disrespect towards other members, other clans, visitors, etc.
 - Any member not following specific guidelines stated by the leadership of the clan. This would include clan events, matches, practices, scrimms, etc.
 - Members who do not follow orders during a scrim, match, or practice (depending on the war admin and how they run things.)

Possible actions: Members of this class must warn and try to find a member of higher rank, specifically in the GS, so they can handle the situation in the most appropriate way. They can either move all parties involved for a discussion, warn them outright and seek council by GS / LS members, and if the situation calls for an immediate kick, and there are no members from the GS/LS present, do so. !!! A warning must be given before any action is taken !!! Members of this class **MUST NOT TEMP BAN** members if they feel the situation calls for such action. Members of this class **MUST NOT TEMP LIMIT** access to media to limit the abuse of the members in question if the actions taken deem such a course. All actions taken must be reviewed by the GS/LS ASAP. If action taken was not just, or was too severe, than the member of this class who took such action could face disciplinary action by the GS/LS.

- Members of this class are to promote a healthy atmosphere within any media our organization is involved. If a member is suspected of violating any policy, ethics, or code of conduct than it is your responsibility to ensure they are educated -- warned -- so that the issue may be resolved in a civil matter. Sometimes harsh measures are required, but you must adhere to and understand that you are responsible for your actions. Any abuse of power will not be tolerated and all actions are reviewed by the GS/LS.
- Members of this class are to understand that they will be looked up to for making decisions on the fly, setting an example, and may have frequent interruptions during melee game play. It is your responsibility to make sure you are able to assist with members of lower rank at any given time to the best of your ability.
- Members understand that they may only take action towards members of lower rank. If the member in question currently holds the same rank as then they must seek a higher rank in order to take action. EX: One SSG can not take action towards another SSG, but can any rank below. Adhere to chain of command
- During the event of an emergency, such as a possible HACK attempt, members of this class **DO NOT** have the authority to take the most appropriate measures necessary to bring the situation to a state of normality. It would be your job to find those who have the capability, if you do not, so that servers can be shut down or files backed up etc. **YOU MUST REPORT TO THE CA ASAP.**

- If you are on the GS you will not be able to participate in any votes that pertain to your own misconduct. You may be asked to leave during a vote, but you are permitted to hear all facts / evidence presented at the time of accusation.
- Forum moderation is not your primary job function, but you will need to be aware and make judgment calls based on the severity of the post or content thereof. Again -- ABUSE OF POWER -- will not be tolerated.
- All actions taken by members of this class will be subject to review by the GS/LS. In some circumstances your decision maybe over-ruled and/or you may face disciplinary action. Just adhere to the BILL of RIGHTS when making your decision and any other policies or BILLS that pertain to such actions.
- It is your responsibility to know all policies, new and old, when making your decisions or taking action. There is no excuse for not knowing or being oblivious.

CLASS 4 - Tier 1 General Staff martial authority

2LT/ 1LT - Second Lieutenant/ First Lieutenant members have Tier 1 GS martial authority. This level of authority is extensive and allows these members to handle any issue that may arise if the situation dictates such an action. All members of this class should be aware that they are responsible for their actions and could face possible review by the GS/LS. Tier 1 GS martial authority is to adhere to the following CODE OF CONDUCT without deviation:

CLASS 4 - Tier 2 General Staff martial authority

CPT/ MAJ - Captain/ Major members have Tier 2 GS martial authority. This level of authority is extensive and would surpass CLASS 4 - Tier 1 and below in making a decision or taking action against a member. These members are to handle any issue that may arise if the situation dictates such an action. All members of this class should be aware that they are responsible for their actions and could face possible review by the GS/LS. Tier 2 GS martial authority is to adhere to the following CODE OF CONDUCT without deviation:

CLASS 4 - Tier 3 General Staff martial authority

LTC/ COL - Lieutenant Colonel members/ AND THE COLONEL member have Tier 3 GS martial authority. Members of this class have served the clan for years and have earned the respect and dignity thereof. This level of authority is the highest level of authority next to that of the CA and would surpass CLASS 4 - Tier 2 and below in making a decision or taking action against a member. These members are to handle any issue that may arise if the situation dictates such an action. All members of this class should be aware that they are responsible for their actions and could face possible review by the GS/LS. Tier 3 GS martial authority is to adhere to the following CODE OF CONDUCT without deviation:

Note: There is only one COL in the clan.

CLASS 4 - Tier 3 GS Code of Conduct

- Members of this class can make a judgment call if another member of less rank is violating any of the following:
 - Making loud or annoying sounds in game, during a match, practice, or other events the clan may be involved.
 - Being disrespectful while on any clan media or sponsored media. This includes directing their disrespect towards other members, other clans, visitors, etc.
 - Any member not following specific guidelines stated by the leadership of the clan. This would include clan events, matches, practices, scrimms, etc.
 - Members who do not follow orders during a scrim, match, or practice (depending on the war admin and how they run things.)

Possible actions: Members of this class must warn and try to rectify the situation in the most appropriate way. They can either move all parties involved for a discussion, warn them outright, and if the situation calls for an immediate kick do so. !!! A warning must be given before any action is taken !!! Members of this class may also TEMP BAN members if they feel the situation calls for such action.

Members of this class may also TEMP LIMIT access to media to limit the abuse of the members in question if the actions taken deem such a course. All actions taken must be reviewed by the GS/LS as soon as possible. If action taken was not just or was to severe than the member of this class who took such action could face disciplinary action by the GS/LS.

- Members of this class are to promote a healthy atmosphere within any media our organization is involved. If a member is suspected of violating any policy, ethics, or code of conduct than it is your responsibility to ensure they are educated -- warned -- so that the issue may be resolved in a civil matter. Sometimes harsh measures are required, but you must adhere to and understand that you are responsible for your actions and abuse of power will not be tolerated.
- Members of this class are to understand that they will be looked up to for making decisions on the fly, setting an example, and may have frequent interruptions during melee game play. It is your responsibility to make sure you are able to assist with members of lower rank at any given time to the best of your ability.
- During the event of an emergency, such as a possible HACK attempt, members of this class have the authority to take the most appropriate measures necessary to bring the situation to a state of normality. It would be your job to find those who have the capability, if you do not, so that servers can be shut down or files backed up etc. Whatever action you take must be reported to the CA ASAP. As always any action you take could result in disciplinary action if it was seen as an abuse of power by the GS/LS.
- Since you are on the GS you will not be able to participate in any votes that pertain to your own misconduct. You may be asked to leave during a vote, but you are permitted to hear all facts / evidence presented at the time of accusation.
- Members understand that they may only take action towards members of lower rank. If the member in question currently holds the same rank as then they must seek a higher rank in order to take action. EX: One LTC can not take action towards another LTC, but can any rank below. Adhere to chain of command
- Forum moderation is not your primary job function, but you will need to be aware and make judgment calls based on the severity of the post or content thereof. Again -- ABUSE OF POWER -- will not be tolerated.
- All actions taken by members of this class will be subject to review by the GS/LS. In some circumstances your decision maybe over-ruled and/or you may face disciplinary action. Just adhere to the BILL of RIGHTS when making your decision and any other policies or BILLS that pertain to such actions.
- It is your responsibility to know all policies, new and old, when making your decisions or taking action. There is no excuse for not knowing or being oblivious.

CLASS 5 - LS martial authority

ALL GENERAL RANKED members are appointed by the CA and act on their behalf if the CA is not present. The Tier 3 GS Code of Conduct is the same as the LS martial authority. The only difference is that a member of the LS can supercede any decision made prior, by using the CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY, and that the CA can supercede any decision that the LS makes. However, the LS and CA are subject to disciplinary action by the GS or clan body if such actions are deemed necessary by a quorum of GS members as outlined in the constitution.
